



EYFS/KS1 Teacher – Job Description

Purpose of the Role

To provide high-quality teaching and learning for pupils in EYFS or Key Stage 1, ensuring all children make progress and achieve their potential in a safe, stimulating, and inclusive environment.

Key Responsibilities

- Plan, prepare, and deliver engaging lessons in line with the EYFS/KS1 curriculum.
- Assess, record, and report on pupils' progress, adapting teaching to meet individual needs.
- Create a positive classroom environment that promotes learning and good behaviour.
- Work collaboratively with colleagues, especially as the class will be combined into a larger class for the afternoons.
- Ensure safeguarding and child protection policies are adhered to at all times.
- Participate in staff meetings, training, and school events as required.
- Undertake paid PPA time for planning, preparation, and assessment.
- Take on a subject leadership role (with appropriate support for ECTs)
- Demonstrate a willingness to go above and beyond to support pupils and the school community.

Teaching and Learning

- Deliver lessons that are creative, inclusive, and differentiated.
- Use formative and summative assessment to inform planning.
- Promote high expectations for all pupils, including those with SEND.
- Foster a love of learning and positive attitudes in pupils.

Classroom Management

- Maintain a safe, orderly, and stimulating classroom environment.
- Implement positive behaviour management strategies.
- Encourage independence and resilience in pupils.

Professional Development

- Engage in continuous professional development.
- Reflect on practice and seek opportunities to improve teaching skills.
- Contribute to the wider life of the school.
- Benefit from a structured ECT induction program, including mentoring and regular feedback.

Safeguarding

- Demonstrate commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.
- Follow school policies and procedures for child protection.
- Maintain confidentiality and professional boundaries.

Additional Duties

- Carry out any other reasonable duties as directed by the Headteacher.
