Curriculum Overview

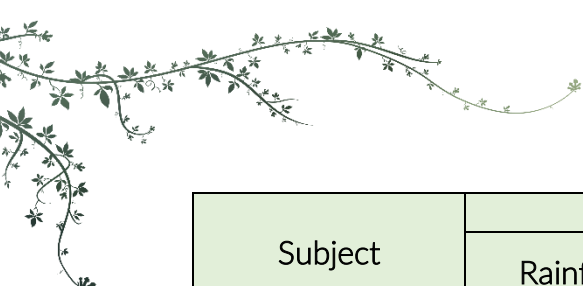
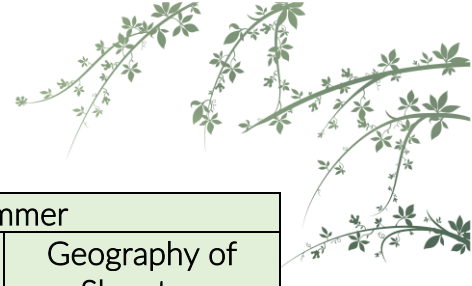
Willow Class

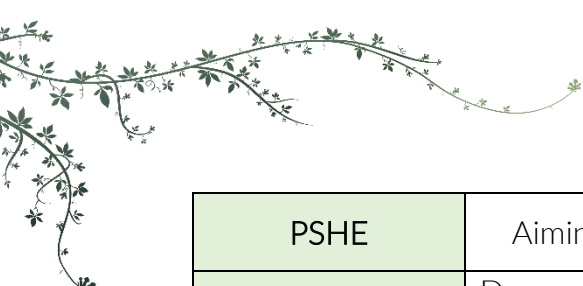
